## MURDER MYSTERY

Q: What time will doors open?

A: Doors will open at 5 PM. The show starts at 6 PM. Please arrive before 6 PM to give us time to have you seated and give you a chance to visit the basket raffle and cash bar.

Q: How will the Murder Mystery dinner work?

A: When you arrive, you will select a table to sit at. Starting at 6 PM, Mystery 207 will stage the crime scene and keep the plot unfolding as they guide guests. As an attendee, you will work to solve the murder OR just observe! You can witness and participate in skits and check evidence. You can even be a suspect! All while sitting at your table and enjoying dinner.

Q: Will there be dinner?

A: Yes! Doors open at 5 and the show begins at 6. Before being seated, you can select any of our appetizers and visit the cash bar. A plated dinner will be served at 7 PM. When purchasing your ticket, you have the option to select one of three dinner choices. If you are bringing a guest or a group, you can write their names and dinner choices, as well. We also encourage you to list any food allergies your group may have.

Q: Do I have to wear a costume?

A: Nope! Costumes are encouraged but not mandatory! The theme is the 1920s Speakeasy, so you can don your flapper dress or millionaire outfit, if you want!

Q: What is the basket raffle?

A: We will have baskets filled with goodies that have been donated by local businesses and put together by KBH staff. Baskets are valued between \$50 and \$700. Before the event and during breaks, you can purchase raffle

tickets (cash or credit card) for any or all baskets. At the end of the night, we will draw the winners. All proceeds benefit the College Scholarship Fund. Adults only.

Q: Can I get my ticket refunded?

A: At this time, we can only refund tickets if the event is cancelled.

Q: Will there be breaks once the show starts?

A: Yes. We will have three breaks. One for dinner to be served and two more to give you a chance to purchase raffle tickets and visit the cash bar.

Q: What ages can come to this event?

A: This event is for people ages 18 and over. It is at the discretion of staff to check IDs when purchasing alcohol and raffle tickets.

Q: Will there be alcoholic beverages?

A: Yes, there will be a cash bar. Of course, for those ages 21 and over. There will be an ATM on site for cash.

Q: What is the College Scholarship Fund?

A: Every spring, KBH works with 10 high schools in Maine to select a number of graduating high school seniors who will be pursuing studies in the behavioral health field. KBH awards scholarships to these students as part of an initiative to promote careers in mental health and help bridge the gap to care for those in need.
