NIGHT OUT

Murder Mystery

Q: What time will doors open?

A: Doors will open at 5 PM. The show starts at 6 PM. Please arrive before 6 PM to give us time to have you seated and give you a chance to visit the basket raffle and cash bar.

Q: How will the Murder Mystery dinner work?

A: When you arrive, you will select a table to sit at. Starting at 6 PM, Mystery 207 will stage the crime scene and keep the plot unfolding as they guide guests. As an attendee, you will work to solve the murder OR just observe! You can witness and participate in skits and check evidence. You can even be a suspect! All while sitting at your table and enjoying food.

Q: Will there be food?

A: Yes! The event includes appetizers, a buffet dinner and dessert. Food will be available before the show and during breaks. The cash bar will open after 5 PM. When purchasing tickets, please list any food allergies you may have!

Q: Do I have to wear a costume?

A: Nope! Costumes are encouraged but not mandatory! The theme is Maine Horror Author, so you dress up as your favorite character from stories by authors like Stephen King and Rick Hautala.

Q: What is the basket raffle?

A: We will have baskets filled with goodies that have been donated by local businesses and put together by KBH staff.

Baskets are valued between \$50 and \$700. Before the event and during breaks, you can purchase raffle tickets (cash or credit card) for any or all baskets. At the end of the night, we will draw the winners. All proceeds benefit the College Scholarship Fund. Ages 21+ only.

Q: Can I get my ticket refunded?

A: At this time, we can only refund tickets if the event is cancelled. However, tickets can be transferred to another name. Please email ekeane@kbhmaine.org for help.

Q: Will there be breaks once the show starts?

A: Yes. We will have three breaks. One for dinner and two more to give you a chance to purchase raffle tickets and visit the cash bar.

Q: What ages can come to this event?

A: This event is for people ages 18 and over. It is at the discretion of staff to check IDs when purchasing alcohol and raffle tickets.

Q: Will there be alcoholic beverages?

A: Yes, there will be a cash bar. Of course, for those ages 21 and over. There will be an ATM on site for cash.

Q: What is the College Scholarship Fund?

A: Every spring, KBH works with 10 high schools in Maine to select a number of graduating high school seniors who will be pursuing studies in the behavioral health field. KBH awards scholarships to these students as part of an initiative to promote careers in mental health and help bridge the gap to care for those in need.
